The New York Division is the New York metropolitan area arm of the Electric Railroaders' Association, and is very active — with monthly meetings, an informative newsletter, and many interesting tours and trips each year.

Our monthly meeting is usually held on the third Friday of each month at St. John's University, 101 Murray Street, in Manhattan, between Greenwich and West Streets. Most of our meetings feature presentations by our members on interesting aspects of electric transit systems in the metropolitan area... or around the world! We also feature occasional speakers from local transit systems on topics of interest. Our occasional auction meetings give a chance to acquire rare transit mementos and publications. Our meeting location is convenient to all public transportation. Doors to the meeting room open at 6:15 pm and the meeting starts at 7:15 pm.

Our monthly newsletter, the **Bulletin**, provides current news on all metropolitan area electric transit, including the New York City subway system, Metro-North and LIRR commuter lines, NJ Transit's trains, the Newark Light Rail line, Staten Island Railway, and Amtrak. It also includes a continuing historical review of our bygone electric transit lines. We're sure you would enjoy reading it every month.

The Division also runs many interesting tours and trips each year in the metropolitan area and beyond. Some of our past tours have visited LIRR Hillside Shop, Staten Island Railway, NYC Transit's Shops at Coney Island and 207th Street, and some of the non-public areas of the New York subway system. We also offer a very popular annual behind-the-scenes tour of Grand Central Terminal, usually held in February. Most of these tours have limited capacity, and our members are the first to hear about them as well as any other special events.

Division membership is only \$50 per year (\$35 for students through undergraduate), surely a bargain at today's prices!

Membership is on an annual calendar basis, and anyone who joins during the year will receive all back issues of the **Bulletin** for the current year.
