# Updated Itinerary for 2022 ERA Convention

Welcome members! This is the **final updated itinerary** for the San Diego Convention. There have been a few changes since we sent you a draft itinerary with your tickets for each activity. **Please review this carefully** and be sure to arrive at all group meeting locations 15 minutes prior to each activity.

## Thursday: July 7, 2022

8:45 a.m.	Leave hotel for 10-minute walk to Old Town Transit Station. A Pronto pass will be distributed to paid participants good for travel on July 7 and 9.
NOTE:	Validate your ERA-provided <b>Pronto Transit Pass</b> at the light rail stop, <b>not</b> the commuter rail stop
9:15 a.m.	Group leaves on new <b>Blue Line north extension</b> (regular service) to UTC Transit Center (last stop) at University Towne Center (UTC), the outdoor shopping mall after which the station is named
9:42 a.m.	Arrive at UTC Transit Center for photo stop
10:03 a.m.	Depart UTC Transit Center on Blue Line regular service to 12th & Imperial Station
10:52 a.m.	Arrive at 12th & Imperial Station. The MTS headquarters building is there.
11:00 a.m.	Tour of San Diego Trolley maintenance shops
12:21 p.m.	Depart 12th & Imperial Station on Green Line for lunch near Santa Fe Depot
12:30 p.m.	Downtown San Diego lunch stop near Santa Fe Depot
NOTE:	See <b>Map 1</b> for suggested restaurants near Santa Fe Depot
2:00 p.m.	Leave Santa Fe Depot for tour of <b>Green and Orange Lines</b> on regular service, led by tour directors Bob Newhouser and Michael Glikin
4:30 p.m.	Return to <b>Old Town Transit Station.</b> Your day pass is also good for travel on the Blue Line south of 12th & Imperial to San Ysidro (border with Mexico).
5:00 p.m7:30 p.m.	On your own to ride MTS services, have dinner, visit Tijuana, or walk back to hotel
7:30 p.m.	Meet at the hotel's <b>La Palma Room</b> for an exciting presentation by Harvey Laner. Harvey's program will be an all-video presentation of Southern California transit updates and the history of Los Angeles and San Diego light rail lines, and their predecessor rail lines.

## Friday: July 8, 2022

8:00 a.m.	Depart hotel on our chartered Sundance motorcoach to Santa Ana (90 minutes)
9:30 a.m11:00 a.m.	Arrive at <b>Santa Ana Regional Transportation Center.</b> Tresa Oliveri and Cleve Cleveland of Orange County Transportation Authority (operator of the OC Streetcar) will lead us on a round trip tour of the <b>OC Streetcar line</b> currently under construction. Tour includes photo stops at the Santa Ana Regional Transportation Center and one other location.
NOTE:	See <b>Map 2</b> for the OC Streetcar alignment in Santa Ana
11:00 a.m.	Depart Santa Ana Regional Transportation Center for Plaza Olvera, adjacent to Old Town Los Angeles
12:15 p.m1:30 p.m.	Arrive at Plaza Olvera. Lunch in the adjacent Olvera Street historic district.

NOTE: See Map 3 for Plaza Olvera restaurants and meeting point adjacent to Old Town Los Angeles

1:30 p.m. After lunch, meet back at Plaza Olvera where the bus dropped everyone off

1:30 p.m2:00 p.m.	Group leaves Plaza Olvera for approximate 15-minute walk through Los Angeles's magnificent Union Station to <b>LA Metro Headquarters Building</b> at Gateway Plaza. An electric cart has been requested from Amtrak for those few who might need a ride through the 11-platform station (about half of the walking time).
2:00 p.m3:00 p.m.	Briefing and Q&A with LA Metro staff to discuss the Crenshaw, Purple Line and Regional Connector rail projects
3:00 p.m3:45 p.m.	Travel by LA Metro's Metro Rail subway (B or D lines), transfer to Expo (E) light rail line to <b>Expo/Crenshaw Station.</b> Each ERA guest will receive a ticket during the LA Metro briefing.
3:45 p.m4:30 p.m.	Meet our chartered bus at Expo/Crenshaw Station and tour Crenshaw line construction with photo stops at <b>Fairview Heights Station</b> (Florence Avenue & West Blvd.) and at <b>Aviation/Imperial Station</b>
NOTE:	See Map 4 for LA Metro Crenshaw/LAX Alignment
4:30 p.m7:30 p.m.	Depart Aviation/Imperial Station for our chartered bus back to hotel. Rest of evening free.

9:00 a.m.	Sundance motorcoach departs our hotel for 90-minute ride to Southern California Railway Museum in Perris (formerly Orange Empire Trolley Museum)
10:30 a.m1:30 p.m.	Streetcar rides and carbarn visits. Admission to Southern California Railway Museum has been prepaid.
1:30 p.m1:45 p.m.	Sundance Motorcoach departs Southern California Railway Museum for the Bombshell Restaurant & Bar
1:45 p.m3:00 p.m.	Lunch at your own expense at Bombshelter Restaurant & Bar, adjacent to the Skydive Perris skydiving field
3:00 p.m4:30 p.m.	Return by Sundance motorcoach to our hotel
6:30 p.m7:00 p.m.	Cash bar opens prior to the ERA 2022 Banquet in the hotel's Pueblo Room
7:00 p.m9:30 p.m.	ERA 2022 Banquet in the Pueblo Room. Buffet dinner will be followed by keynote address by E. Wayne Terry, chief operating officer of MTS San Diego Trolley, Inc.
NOTE:	Admission to the banquet is by itinerary letter indicating your attendance. Don't forget to bring it!


## Sunday: July 10, 2022


Note:	Pick up your ERA-paid box lunch starting 8:30 a.m. <b>at the hotel's Prado Room before leaving our hotel!</b> There is a selection of turkey, roast beef, and tuna salad box lunches. If you have a preference, get there early to make sure you get your selected lunch box. There are rest stops but no lunch stops today.
9:00 a.m.	Leave hotel with our group for 10-minute walk to <b>Old Town Transit Center</b>
NOTE:	Validate your Pronto Transit Pass at the Old Town Transit Center commuter rail platform, NOT the light rail station where you validated it on Thursday
9:27 a.m10:22 a.m.	ERA Group boards regular service Coaster train from Old Town Transit Center to <b>Oceanside Terminal.</b> Time allowed for rest stop before boarding <b>Sprinter</b> hybrid light rail DMU at 11:03 a.m.
11:03 a.m12:56 p.m.	Round trip on Sprinter from Oceanside Terminal to Escondido
12:56 p.m1:31 p.m.	Rest stop upon return to Oceanside
1:31 p.m2:37 p.m.	Take regular-service Coaster train from Oceanside to Santa Fe Depot
NOTE:	Those needing to <b>leave early</b> can get off at Old Town Transit Center and walk back to our hotel
2:50 p.m3:30 p.m.	Leave Santa Fe Depot for a round trip on the Silver Line, San Diego Trolley's 2.7-mile downtown loop that operates two restored PCC streetcars. Last event of the convention.

NOTE: The Silver Line trip is subject to cancellation depending on MTS needs for a San Diego Padres game
