Early images (1948-75) are from various collections, most notably including late Chicago area railfans George Krambles and Joe Diaz, as well as New York railfan photographer Gerry Landau. They include scenes of many abandoned routes as well as some of the system's original and PCC-era rolling stock. Also included are some of George's own images (1980-2007), which include some scenes of recently discontinued operations, recently retired rolling stock, and some contemporary views.

As the Board decided not to pick a new date until the new diesels have been accepted, and in view of the desire not to schedule the trip during colder weather, we will reschedule the trip for sometime in the spring of 2010, assuming acceptance of the new diesels. Saturday, September 12 Tour of the NYC Transit Car Equipment Maintenance Shop at E. 180th Street in the Bronx We anticipate a tour of 60-90 minutes beginning at 10:30 AM. Unfortunately, we cannot visit the Unionport Tower nearby due to current construction there. We plan an optional trip after the tour involving a ride on the #5 line to Dyre Avenue, a visit to the recently rehabilitated Gun Hill Road station on the #2 line, a lunch stop, and then a ride on the Bx12 SBS bus. An updated flyer is enclosed with this mailing. Please note that the meeting spot for this trip is the <u>south</u> end of the <u>northbound</u> platform at the E. 180th Street station.

Saturday, November 7 – Tentatively, a trip involving Hudson-Bergen Light Rail. No further specifics are available at this time, but please mark this date on your calendar and look for a flyer with the October mailing.
