

JOIN THE ERA AND THE RRE FOR A

FALL PUBLIC TRANSIT RIDE AND NJT RIVER LINE & PATCO SHOP TOURS

SATURDAY, OCTOBER 19, 2013

The Electric Railroaders' Association is pleased to announce a trip that will take us on several different rail lines: NJ Transit's Northeast Corridor, River Line and Atlantic City Line; PATCO; and SEPTA's Trenton Line. In addition, the trip will include tours of the NJT River Line Shop and PATCO's Lindenwold Shop. This trip will take place on **Saturday, October 19, 2013**.

The tour group will catch the NJ Transit Northeast Corridor (Trenton) train currently scheduled to leave NY Penn Station at 8:14 am and meet in the first car (westernmost car) open for passengers (the actual first car may be closed to passengers). If it is more convenient for you, you can catch this same train at 8:23 am out of Secaucus Junction or at 8:32 am out of Newark Penn Station. In Trenton, we will transfer to a NJ Transit River Line train to 36th Street, where we participate in a River Line Shop tour adjacent to that station. After the tour, we will take the River Line to the Walter Rand Transportation Center in Camden, where we will transfer to a PATCO train to Lindenwold. After a brief lunch stop, we will get a tour of the PATCO Lindenwold Shop. We will then take the NJ Transit Atlantic City Line to Philadelphia 30th Street Station, from which we will take a SEPTA Trenton Line train to Trenton to transfer to an NJ Transit Northeast Corridor train back to NY Penn Station. It is estimated that we will return to NY Penn Station around 8:30 pm, after which you can have dinner on your own.

Join us for a lovely Fall ride on several train lines, supplemented by two interesting and informative shop tours. The ticket price for the trip and shop tours is only **\$25.00**. You should note that this price does not include any transportation costs; each participant will purchase his or her own transit tickets/fares. The cost of the train rides and lunch is the responsibility of each individual attendee. DEPARTURE TIMES

Each attendee is responsible for being at the departure point(s) several minutes prior to the scheduled departure time. With regard to the initial departure times, you should be aware that numerous g.o.'s are frequently in effect on the subways almost every weekend and these may delay your normal trip from your home or connection to the trip departure point. It is your responsibility to check for g.o.'s and other service notices that may affect your trip beforehand, so that you can plan your arrival time with plenty of cushion to spare. There will be no ticket refunds for failure to show up on time. It is important that you adhere to announced return departure times.

RULES OF CONDUCT
