- A complete track map of the Chicago and West Towns Railways trolley lines in the western suburbs of Chicago. This 11" x 17" document is a welcomed addition to the collections of any person with an interest in the Chicago area
- A route map of Tri-Met's (Portland) South Line to Clackamas County and Milwaukie, Oregon. This 8 1/2" x 11" plan shows all stations and important intersecting streets. This line is scheduled to open in 2009 and this map will encourage all transit enthusiasts to re-visit the city to view this and other large extensions
- A route map of the 385-mile long Great Slave Lake Railway as planned in 1965. Three lines are shown: Hines-Peace River, Alberta, Grimshaw, Alberta to Hay River, North West Territory and the branch line to Pine Point, NWT on the Great Slave Lake. A track connection is with the Northern Alberta Railway (now a part of the Canadian National Railway) at Peace River, Alberta and the NAR line further connects with both the Canadian National and Canadian Pacific Rys. at Edmonton. 8 1/2" x 11". Excellent map !!!
- A 1924 route map of the Northampton Transit Co. trolley lines which ran between Easton, PA and Bangor, PA and between Tatamy, PA and Nazareth, PA. 8 1/2" x 11". Quite interesting and unusual
- An 8 1/2" x 11" route map of the New Haven and Shore Line Ry. This 34-mile line connected New Haven and Saybrook. It was originally operated by the Shore Line Electric Railway, but because of high operating costs, the line was shut down in 1919, but reopened as the New Haven and Shore Line Ry. in July, 1923. This map depicts the re-opened line and shows all the towns through which it ran
- A seven-page 8 1/2" x 11" brochure produced by the New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad Company entitled, "A General Description of the 4400 Series Electric Commuter Coaches for the NY, NH & H Electrified Zone." It contains a complete description of the equipment as well as an 11" x 17" car diagram drawing giving complete car dimensions. It's perfect for modelers. This brochure is one of the very few printed items remaining from the time when these 100 electric multiple unit cars (including all sub-classes) ran between Grand Central and New Haven. Dated September 20, 1954 and issued when these dual-voltage cars started running in passenger service. Remember, these cars featured a very early application of the heavy mercury arc rectifier on board to convert the 11 KV overhead alternating current to 600 volts direct current to operate the car's traction motors, compressors and other electrical equipment. Extremely rare !!!
