- A February, 1966 route map of the trolley network in Pittsburgh Railways Company. Also included is a list of lines that were still running in February, 1966, a list of motorized or closed trolley lines and their closing dates, a differentiation between single and double track, street-running, private right of way, location of car houses and connecting trolley operators. 8 1/2" x 11". Great collector's item.
- A 1920 route map of the Municipal Railway of San Francisco, showing all their trolley and connecting municipal motor coach lines. 8 1/2" x 11". Very unusual and a great addition to your library.
- A route map and description of the routing of all 11 remaining Municipal Railway of San Francisco trolley lines prior to the great merger with the Market Street Railway network in 1944. 8 1/2" x 11". Rare !!
- A route map of the Atlantic Shore Railway, whose network 100 years ago connected Dover and Portsmouth, New Hampshire with Sanford, Kennebunkport and Biddeford, Maine. 8 1/2" x 11". Very nice, indeed.
- A Souvenir Brochure of the August 1, 1998 Metro North Railroad using an 1100-series multiple unit electric cars. Included are a list of photo stops, a car diagram for the 1100-1186 Series Pullman Standard electric multiple unit cars, an additional specification sheet when these cars were in the 4600-4783 group, a 1950 roster of all New York Central Railroad electric multiple unit cars, a 1945 route map of the former New York Central Railroad Electric Division, a track diagram of both the Upper and Lower Levels of Grand Central Terminal and the yards at North White Plains, Brewster and Harmon.
