- A 1937 route map of the Indiana Railroad System and connecting electric rail lines, steam railroads and motor coach routes. This fascinating 8 1/2" x 11" map is a "must" in every interurban enthusiasts' collection and is quite enjoyable.
- A 1913 route map of the passenger and freight lines of the Oregon Electric Railway, including the Portland-Eugene main line, the Gray-Cornwallis branch, the Portland-Hillsborough-Forest Grove line, the Portland-Burlington line and the Tualatin-McMinnville line. Extremely rare; 8 1/2" x 11".
