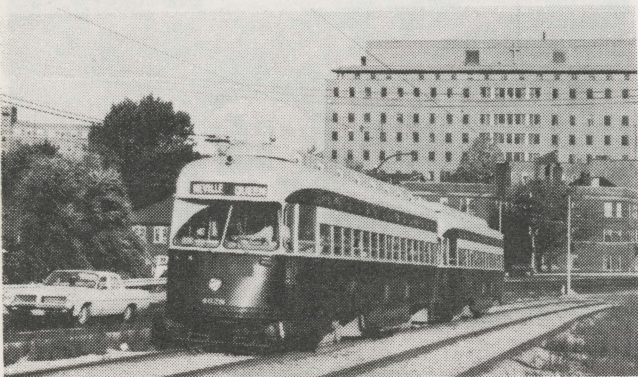


SUNDAY

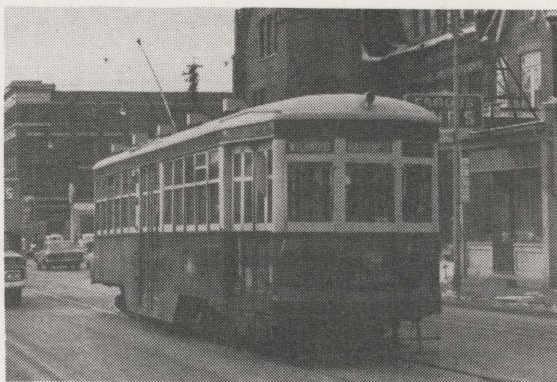
FRIDAY - MOVIE SHOW

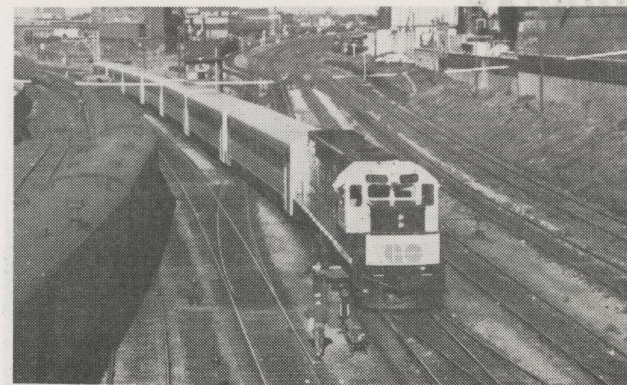
EXTRA !
