Dear fellow E.R.A. member:-

Once again the Nominating Committee has the important but difficult task of presenting to E.R.A. members a slate of two qualified candidates for each elective office to serve for the year 1967. The elective offices are:

PRESIDENT, FIRST VICE-PRESIDENT, 2ND VICE-PRESIDENT & RECORDING SECRETARY,  
VICE-PRESIDENT IN CHARGE OF DIVISIONS, SECRETARY, TREASURER.
