

FIRST TRAIN THRU CHRYSTIE ST. APRIL 8, 1967

On Saturday, April 8, 1967 the Electric Railroaders Association, Inc. will operate the first passenger train thru the Chrystie Street connection. This historic trip, will offer a once in a lifetime opportunity to be on board the very first train. Plan to be with us now!

In addition to the Broadway-Lafayette(IND) to Essex St.(BMT) portion of the trip we will also cover the following routes: A high speed express run on the middle track of the Flushing line, a run on the Astoria line(IRT Lo-V cars have not been in regular service on this line since 1949!). The complicated operation of switching from the IRT to the IND via the BMT and all at Queens Plaza station will be seen! Operation of the Lo-V cars over the BMT Broadway-Brooklyn line, Jamaica line and Canarsie line for the first time in passenger service will be another highlight! We will operate into the ancient East New York Yard for a rare look see behind the scenes. You will also be able to photograph the only street grade crossing on the New York transit system!

Equipment on the trip will be old, but warm and wonderful, IRT Lo-V cars. These cars, almost 50 years old, have long been considered the most colorful in New York. Completely rebuilt and refurbished they will add "something old" to our trip thru Chrystie Street.

Trip will depart Times Square, Flushing line station(lower level) at 9:30 AM Sharp!
