The special train will leave Woodside promptly at 9:05 AM. Tickets will be honored free between New York (Penn Station) and Woodside on the 8:44 AM train. In the evening tickets will be honored on the connecting trains at Jamaica to New York or Brooklyn.

A two hour lay-over at Greenport will permit sight-seeing or a relaxing meal at <u>Mitchell's Restaurant</u>. The pride of Long Island, Mitchell's is known for their excellent food.
