## EX - PRR MP - 54 CLASS ELECTRIC CARS

For many years the MP-54 car was a familiar sight to Pennsy riders in the New York and Philadelphia areas. Now, in the twilight of their existence, these cars are quickly being replaced by streamlined cars. This will be an excellent opportunity to ride these open-windowed cars. To make this an even more interesting trip the cars will operated for the first time in passenger service over the electrified lines of the former New York, New Haven and Hartford Railroad to New Haven, with a side trip over the New Caanan Branch. After leaving Pennsylvania Station the majestic Hell Gate Bridge will be the gateway to the New Haven Railroad! This will be a memorable trip that, most probably, will never be repeated. Photo stops and movie runs are scheduled.

### BRANFORD TROLLEY MUSEUM

During the layover in New Haven, a side trip to the Branford Trolley Museum has been arranged. This will be an excellent opportunity to visit one of the largest operating museums with its massive collection of trolleys and elevated cars. Fare includes bus transportation and a ride "Down Memory Lane," (time at museum - approximately one hour) \$ 2.00. Fare.

A box lunch will be provided on the train consisting of juice, milk, two sandwiches, pie and candy bar. The New Haven station area has only limited eating facilities. \$ 2.50 each.
