## An Old Fashion Subway Ride

The once-familiar IRT standard car, often called "Lo-V", for many years provided virtually all service on the IRT subway lines in New York City. All these well-remembered cars have been retired and have been used in regular passenger service since the early days of 1964;

This trip will cover lines of the IRT and IND in Manhattan, The Bronx and Queens. The connecting tunnels between the 42nd Street Shuttle and the north-south line, part of the original 1904 route, will be a very interesting highlight of the excursion. Many scenic photo stops are to be made.

It is planned to cover the City Hall Station, Lexington Avenue, White Plains Road, Woodlawn-Jerome lines. With a special side trip to the IND Jamaica yard, the IRT cars will cover the IND Queens Boulevard line, the Sixth Avenue express tracks, Second Avenue lay-up tracks, Concourse Yard as well as the Flushing line.
