The pleasure of a first class train ride, a relaxing meal and the crisp salt air will be yours on a 200 mile outing along Long Island's south shore! From the activity of New York City to the quiet beauty of Nassau and Suffolk Counties our special train will wind its way on a pleasant summer day. This will be a rare opportunity to ride one of the most unusual first class trains ever operated.

OPEN PLATFORM OBSERVATION CAR 'JAMAICA'

This very special car will bring up the rear of this train. This car, which was built in the early years of this century, has served on the Nevada Northern and Delaware, Lackawanna & Western Railroads before finding a home on the Long Island. This car will be open to all passengers.

Our train will be a mixed bag of unusual and exotic equipment. Each car will be different inside and out and will be representative of the great golden age of rail passenger travel in America. The train consist will be:

- "Amagansett" ex- Baltimore & Ohio "Nappanee" - five compartment observation lounge.
- "Asharoken" ex- Erie Lackawanna "Phoebe Snow" - tavern parlor-lounge closed observation car.
- "Tuckahoe" ex- Union Pacific "Weber River" parlor-lounge.
- "Apagogne" ex- Florida East Coast "Lake Okeechobee" full parlor-lounge closed observation car.

In addition to the Montauk Branch our special will also visit the Long Island City terminal and the seldom visited line through Forest Park. A brief stop will be made at Belmont Park station.

Arrangements have been made for a bus tour of Montauk Point during the lay-over at Montauk. This is always a popular excursion and one that is highly recommended. For those on the tour a lunch stop will be made on the Montauk fishing pier.

TRAIN WILL LEAVE HUNTERSPOINT AVENUE at 8:40AM. This station is adjacent to the IRT Flushing line stop at Hunterspoint Avenue (two stops from the Grand Central subway station). Passengers may also take the 9:10AM train from either Pennsylvania Station N.Y. or Flatbush Avenue, Brooklyn and connect with the special train at Jamaica. Special returns to Jamaica at 7:00PM. Your trip tickets will be honored to or from New York or Brooklyn on connecting trains.

In assigning seats every effort will be made to place you in the car you select on a first come basis, however the Association reserves the right to assign seats based on the capacity of the cars on the train.
