

Farewell to the Jamaica Elevated



Sunday, September 11, 1977

To commemorate the closing of the outer portion of the Jamaica Avenue Elevated from Queens Boulevard to 168th Street, a last passenger train will be operated on Sunday, September 11, 1977 after the termination of regular passenger service.

This will be a last opportunity to ride this portion of a line that contains some of the most interesting elevated portions of the transit system. In addition our train will cover the Brighton, West End, Fourth Avenue, Montague Street, Nassau St. and Sixth Avenue routes. The out-of-service trackage between the Broadway-Lafayette and Essex Street stations will also be covered. A brief side trip to the East New York Yard is also part of the schedule.

The equipment will be the oldest BMT cars available and it is our plan to use two different types. Lots of photo stops and a couple of good movie opportunities. A rest stop will be made enroute.
