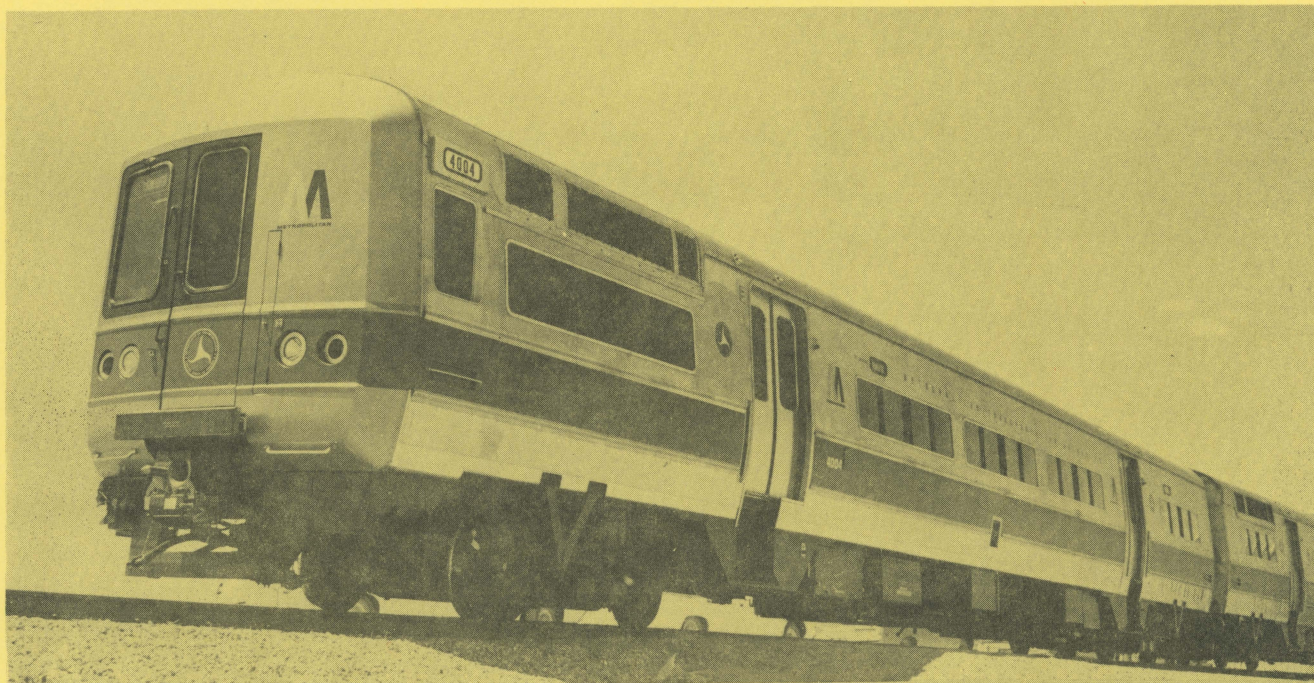


LONG ISLAND RAIL ROAD SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 13, 1977



GAS TURBINE / ELECTRIC SPECIAL

The Long Island Rail Road's Gas Turbine/Electric cars, a unique design that permits operation on electrified and non-electrified portions of the railroad, will tour a number of lines on Sunday, November 13, 1977.

In addition to riding these unusual cars, you will have many opportunities to photograph the GT/E train in unusual locations. The trip will cover the main line to Calverton, the Port Jefferson Branch to Kings Park, the Montauk Branch from Jamaica to Long Island City, the freight-only Montauk cut-off and side trips to the Peconic-Grumman and Kings Park State Hospital spurs. A lunch stop will be made **enroute**.

This should be a most unusual and interesting excursion. Plan to join us for a most enjoyable day. The trip returns to Jamaica at 6:00 PM.
